



# **Business Category Restrictions** for ThryvPay<sup>®</sup>

## Restricted categories for businesses not authorized to establish a ThryvPay account.

Clients can still take advantage of all the other software benefits, as well as, creating and sending estimates and invoices. However, they will not be able to accept Online Payments or Mobile QuickPay options if they fall under any of the restricted categories as mentioned below.

#### **Most Impacted Categories**

- 2. Buyer or membership clubs, including dues associated with such clubs
- 3. Credit counseling or credit repair agencies
- 4. Credit protection or identity theft protection services
- 5. Direct marketing or subscription offers or services
- 6. Infomercial sales
- 7. Internet/mail order/telephone order pharmacies or pharmacy referral services (where fulfillment of medication is performed with an Internet or telephone consultation, absent a physical visit with a physician including re-importation of pharmaceuticals from foreign countries)
- 8. Unauthorized multi-level marketing businesses
- 9. Inbound or outbound telemarketers
- 10. Alcohol and wine shops
- 11. Automotive tire outlets
- 12. Bicycle shops sales and service
- 13. Boat rentals and leasing
- 14. Books, periodicals, and newspapers
